Article 2 – MEMBERSHIP


- 2.01 Membership in the Association shall consist of the following classes
- a. **Contractor Members.** All siding Contractors, in both new construction and renovations, shall be eligible for membership. Contractor members must attend or have a company representative attend 75% of the General Membership Meetings. The majority of income must be realized from supply and install applications.
 - b. **Manufacturer/Distributor Members.** Are members who manufacturer or supply siding products, supplies, equipment and services. One member from this category is eligible to election as a Board Member and entitled to vote on all motions. This representative also carries the vote at all general meetings.
 - c. **Honorary Members,** as approved by the general membership.
 - d. **Affiliate Members.** Professionals such as lawyers, inspectors, architects, other related associations and government officials.
- 2.02 **Requirements of membership.** Unless otherwise waived by the Board of Directors, all members of the Association must:
1. have been in business a minimum of two years.
 2. have not changed names or filed for bankruptcy in the last two years.
 3. have the appropriate business licenses.
 4. carry a minimum of two million dollars liability insurance
 5. have valid WCB number
 6. operate in full compliance of the laws of the municipality and province where they conduct business
 7. agree to install to applicable Building Codes and manufacturer's specifications as minimum standards.
 8. be COR certified and the certifications must be maintained through the annual audit process, if you are a contractor member.
 9. maintain a safety program if you are a manufacturer or supplier member.
 10. follow the SCAA By-laws and Code of Ethics.
 11. address and attempt to resolve customer complaints made to the Association office or affiliated Associations.
 12. be current with the Association, keeping all invoices paid up to date.
- 2.03 Application for membership in the Association shall be made to the office of the Siding Contractors' Association of Alberta on the forms provided. Copies of business licenses and proof of insurance coverage shall accompany the application. A cheque for membership fees and initiation fees shall accompany the application. Upon receipt of the application the Association Office will:
- i. Contact affiliated Associations (ie Better Business Bureau) for references
 - ii. Advise all members electronically that a membership application has been received, and presented to the Board of Directors for their information and approval, and if approved by the Board will be voted on at the next meeting.
- 2.04 Each application must be sponsored by two contractors, or one contractor and one manufacturer/supplier member in good standing with the Association. All members are entitled to sponsor new members. Once a membership application is received all members will be notified of the application and the sponsors prior to the meeting where the application is to be considered.
- 2.05 All new applications for membership must be approved by 50% plus one majority of the members in attendance and eligible to vote when the vote is conducted.
- 2.06 It shall be a condition of membership that if the application is accepted, the member will be bound by and agrees to all the provisions, obligations, and requirements contained in the Association's By-Laws.

Please submit the enclosed membership application, along with a cheque for the appropriate membership fees to the Association office at P.O. Box 624, Didsbury, Alberta T0M 0W0. Your cheque will not be cashed until your application has been accepted by the Association.

Our annual membership fees are due each January and the membership year runs on a calendar basis. If you apply for membership after March of the calendar year, please contact the Association office at 403-291-9707 as we may be able to pro-rate your membership dues for your first year.

Once your membership is approved you will be entitled to use the Association logo on your business cards, vehicles and other advertising materials.
